Celebrating and being behind that altar as a priest at St. Christopher's is something I had not done yet until Sunday and was incredibly special. It was a gift to both me and those who have walked with me through this part of my journey, especially being able to place the wafer in everyone's hands.

St. Christopher's and its people hold a special place in my heart along with St. Mark's Jacksonville and its people. Both are very much a part of who I am today both as a Christian and as a priest. They have both walked with me through the good, the bad, and the ugly, through some critical times in my life. And while I do not have the long histories with them that many of you all have with Trinity, Our Saviour, or Grace, I get how you all feel about whichever historic building is your home church. I understand how it feels to walk in and immediately feel like you are home. How much the people and the memories mean and how you couldn't imagine life without them, whether it is one particular building or all of them.

I am simply grateful that you all have invited me and are allowing me to be a part of all of those memories and history and help make some new memories and history!

Calling all those who are Lay Eucharistic Ministers and those who would like to be Lay Eucharistic Ministers: Please plan to attend one of these training sessions. They will be after Hospitality. Current Lay Eucharistic Members are required to attend to update their license. If we need to schedule another one in November we will.

In case you are wondering, a Lay Eucharistic Minister is a lay person licensed by the bishop to administer the consecrated elements of the eucharist. Lay eucharistic ministers may be licensed to administer the consecrated bread and wine at any celebration of the eucharist in the absence of a sufficient number of priests and deacons to assist the celebrant. Prior to the current lay ministry canons, specially licensed lay

readers administered the chalice at the eucharist and were known as "chalice bearers."






