

I want to know your favorite hymns!

One of the topics during the Vestry Retreat was worship. Caleb Connor suggested we give everyone a chance to submit their favorite hymns, and we work to incorporate those in our Sunday services. Just like our Book of Common Prayer is beautiful and provides us with wonderful liturgies and prayers, our Hymnal 1982 is beautiful and contains a variety of hymns. The depth of our Hymnal is incredible. During May and the beginning of June, we will have cards available for you to submit your favorite hymns. You may also email them to churchoftheridge@gmail.com. If you do not have a hymnal at home, you are welcome to come early or stay a little late on Sunday morning to browse through the hymnal or you may look online at https://hymnary.org/hymnal/eh1982.

We will begin incorporating the hymns during the season after Pentecost, unless someone submits an Easter hymn that we have not already planned to sing. We hope to incorporate most of the hymns in the season after Pentecost (the long green season). However, we will not use submissions for specific seasons or feast days until the appropriate time. Peggy Ann and I work together to plan the hymns for Sunday, and we will use that list as a guide in addition to the recommended hymns for the day. If you do not hear your hymns immediately, do not worry we will get around to singing everyone's hymns as long as they are in The Episcopal Church's approved liturgical resources.

I invite you to submit as many hymns as you like. When you submit a card, please include your name and if there is a memory or a reason the hymn is a favorite, please include that. I would love to incorporate that into our bulletin as a way for us to get to know one another.

Peggy Ann and the choir are excited about the chance to learn new hymns and add hymns to our repertoire. I am excited to learn about everyone's favorite hymns and to hear why they are your favorite hymns or a special memory that is tied

to those hymns.


